



WBO-Borderpol Privacy Policy

Information Routinely Collected by Borderpol

When you visit the site to read or download information, Borderpol routinely collects *only* the following information: the name of the domain from which you access the Internet; the date and time you access our site; and the Internet address of the Web Site from which you linked directly to our site. Borderpol uses the information to measure traffic on the site, and to help make the site more useful to visitors.

Information You Submit

Borderpol collects personal information, such as names and email addresses, from visitors when they take actions such as joining a Borderpol mailing list, subscribing to a blog or other publication, providing feedback about the site, or during financial transactions involving Borderpol -related organizations or companies (specifically, but not limited to, SafeBorders.Net, World Security Index.com) In addition, third party providers of goods and services may collect similar information. These providers are clearly identified, and questions about the privacy policies or procedures of these third-party providers should be directed to them.

If you communicate with Borderpol via regular mail, online form, voice mail, email, or otherwise provide information to Borderpol through some other method, all information you provide is on a non-confidential or non-proprietary basis, and Borderpol will retain copyright to that material. With the exception of personal information such as names (with the exception of initials or a single first name), addresses, financial data, and email addresses, or other content that would uniquely identify a private individual, Borderpol may use your submission without restrictions of any kind whatsoever, and all information may be disclosed, distributed, modified, reproduced and used in any manner that Borderpol chooses, without providing any compensation to you.

Sharing Information

In order to promote border security and enhance the mobility of people, Borderpol may also forward limited personal information, such as name and contact information, to an appropriate public organization for review (including, but not limited to, national border services, aviation security groups and transportation safety boards). While this is routinely done for border management complaints submitted through this site, it may also be done for other information at the sole discretion of Borderpol.

Protection of Information

Borderpol takes appropriate security measures to protect sensitive information from unauthorized access, changes, disclosure, or destruction. These measures include a formal management process for information and information protection, as well as physical security measures for computers, hard drives, flash drives, and other places or devices where sensitive data is stored or processed.

Communications from Borderpol

Subscribers to any Borderpol mailing list, RSS type feed, or any communications process may routinely receive messages associated with those communications processes, as well as messages related to other Borderpol activities. Subscribers who no longer want to receive any communications from a particular mailing list or communications activity can follow the appropriate procedures to unsubscribe from that list. Subscribers may also contact Borderpol directly to make such a request.

Information Sharing

Borderpol or its representatives may allow outside access to personal information such as names, addresses, and email addresses to contractors and companies that have a legitimate or contractual need to know that information in order to support the content and services provided by Borderpol. These entities are bound by confidentiality agreements between themselves and Borderpol.

Third-party Privacy Policies

Third-party providers of advertising, information, services, or other functions within the Borderpol website may collect information about your visit such as the pages visited and the time spent during your visit. These third-party providers are responsible for the use of this information.

Outside Links and Services

This site makes use of links to outside sites. These links to information and services are provided as a convenience to users of Borderpol or its related services and as a way to enhance the information contained within the Borderpol site. Borderpol is not responsible for the content of any other sites or any products or services that may be offered through other sites. Borderpol is also not responsible for the privacy policies of these sites.
